PROGRAM	WHAT IS IT?	BASIC REQUIREMENTS
<b>CalWORKs</b>	Gives cash assistance and services to eligible needy California families.	<b>Families must provide proof of:</b> Income Property Citizenship Age Social Security number Residence Work or School Status Other Information
<b>Food Stamps</b>	Supplements the income of low income individuals and families by allowing them to buy food for good health.	<b>Households must meet eligible requirements in the following areas:</b> Citizenship Income Property Residence Work Requirements Other information
<b>Medi-Cal</b>	Provides medical services for children and adults in low income families who are medically needy or medically indigent.	<b>Families must provide proof of:</b> Income Age Residence Property
<b>Child Care</b>	Provides free or almost free child care programs which are available to provide a safe and healthy environment that supports the development and growth of young children.	<b>Families must provide proof of:</b> Residence Child age Work or School/Training Status Income
<b>Foster Care</b>	Provides temporary out-of-home care for children who have been neglected, abused, or exploited.	<b>Eligibility based on:</b> Age Residency Citizenship Deprivation of parents due to absence, health, death, or unemployment
<b>Kinship Care (Kin-GAP)</b>	Provides family support services and payments to relative caregivers and the dependent children placed in their homes by the juvenile court and to those who are at risk of court.	<b>Eligibility based on:</b> Age Residency Citizenship Deprivation of parents due to absence, health, death, or unemployment
<b>Department of Aging and Adult Services</b>	Provides a range of services and activities necessary to prevent or remedy situations in which vulnerable adults are endangered because of exploitation, neglect or incapacity, or in which adults are endangered or abused by the treatment of others.	<b>Program/Services available:</b> Senior Nutrition Adult Protective Svcs Legal Svcs Multi-Purpose Senior Prog.
