Outcomes of CNAP Collaborative process in San Francisco:

1. Participation in each other's events, such as the Children's Council of San Francisco Annual Nutrition Education Fair in March 2007 and April 2008, Wu Yee Children's Services Health Fair in April 2007 and Head Start in September 2007
2. In process to develop a nutrition education message to be done in coordination with FSNE funded SFUSD Nutrition Education Project, to be disseminated through all CNAP member agencies
3. Development of multilingual (English, Spanish and Chinese) joint program brochures
4. Promotion of SF WIC Program through SF Food Stamp website to promote cross program referrals
5. Training of SF WIC, UC Cooperative Extension, City College of San Francisco Nutrition Assistant Program on CNAP member programs
6. Developed a logo and slogan to represent our active collaboration and identify ourselves as FNS Programs in action

Current Projects include:

1. SFUSD Student Art Poster Contest with Nutrition Education message promoting fruit and vegetable intake
2. Planning for a joint nutrition education, program collaboration event for National Nutrition Month in 2009, to announce the SFUSD Student Art Poster winners and the joint nutrition education campaign through SF MUNI buses.
